LANDSCAPING WITH TREES AND PLANTS

Every year during rainy season, University takes the initiative of plantation inside the university campus. The Botany department of the University has YPS Pangtey botanical garden and promote different NGO and institute for plantation. The University takes the advantage of free plant from the forest department and plantation takes place every year inside the campus and in the adjoining areas. Under Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan the University has adopted five villages where the University do the plantation activity.

The University has 745 full grown trees, 1320 small trees and 4559 hedge plants covering 63162 sq. ft grassland. The forestry department has developed a mushroom cultivation. Moreover, the institution's dedication to preserving local heritage extends to safeguarding endangered species like Patwa (*Meizotropis pellita*), demonstrating biodiversity conservation. By prioritizing the protection of indigenous flora and fauna, Kumaun University contributes significantly to preserving the region's ecological balance and promoting biodiversity conservation at large. In a location inside the campus (Botany Department) some medicinal plants are also planted over last five years
