

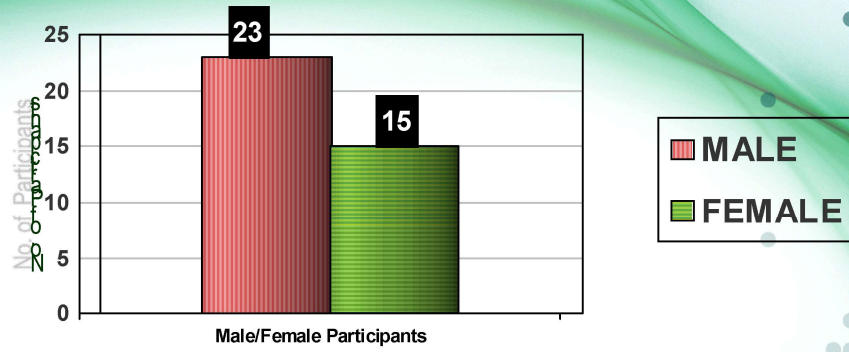

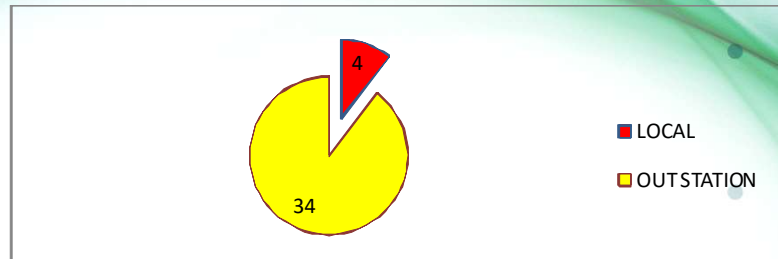

## MALE AND FEMALE PARTICIPANTS

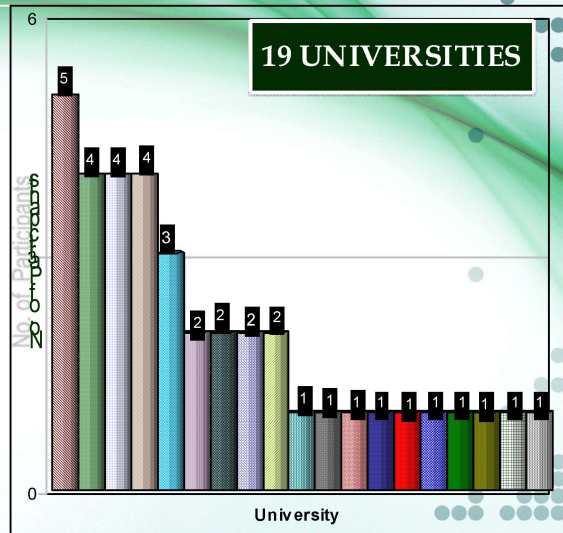

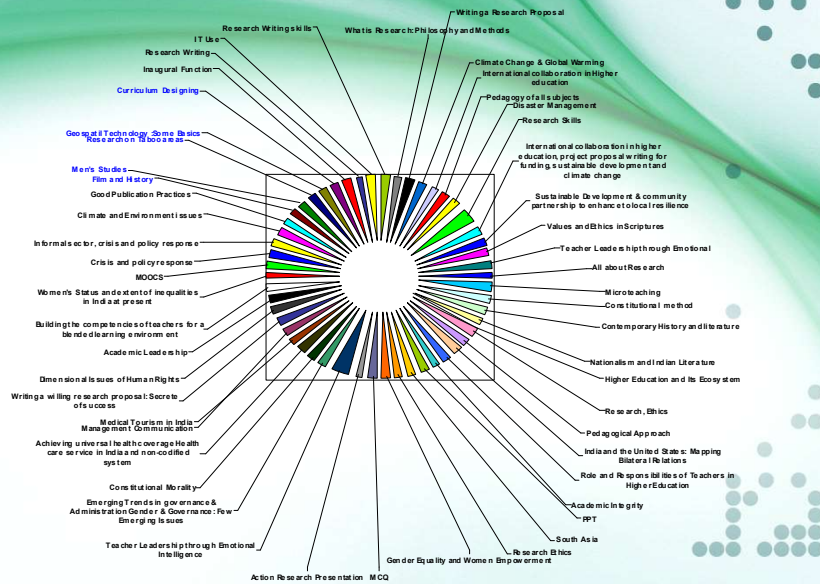
