Feedback Analysis Report: Kumaun University, Nainital Academic Session: 2022-2023

This report presents a comprehensive analysis of student feedback collected during the academic session 2022-23 at Kumaun University, Nainital. It offers insights into the strengths and areas for enhancement of the institution, shedding light on the overall satisfaction levels among students. Feedback was gathered via an online rating system, utilizing a scale ranging from 1 to 5, where 5 denoted 'Excellent,' 4 represented 'Very Good,' 3 indicated 'Good,' 2 stood for 'Average,' and 1 signified 'Below Average.' This methodology facilitated a quantitative assessment of student satisfaction across various domains, including course content, teaching-learning methods, and the evaluation process.

According to student responses, the university received predominantly positive ratings, with an impressive 83.39% of students rating it as 'Excellent.' A breakdown of responses is as follows:

- Excellent (5): 82.55%
- Very good (4): 4.60%
- · Good (3): 2.91%
- Average (2): 2.73%
- Below Average (1): 6.47% These results indicate a highly favorable perception of the university, with 91.14% of respondents rating it as 'Very Good' or 'Excellent.'

Feedback was solicited on five key aspects of course content and delivery, highlighting the university's proficiency in these areas. The evaluation encompassed syllabus coverage, detailed topic discussions, teacher expertise, communication skills, and the ability to inspire students. The high average scores received underscore the institution's excellence in this domain.

Students assessed eleven factors related to teaching and learning, revealing a positive outlook on various aspects including teacher punctuality, engagement, preparedness, guidance,

Moreover, students appreciated the use of modern teaching aids, relevance of course material to real-world scenarios, friendly demeanour of teachers, provision of unique study materials, unbiased assistance, and discussion of career aspirations.



Students acknowledged timely assessments, provision of answers and feedback by teachers, and perceived fairness and impartiality in the evaluation process.


