


Maximum percentage (63.2%) of employee was satisfied with the overall environment and culture of the University while 31.6 % employee were observed to be very satisfied. Out

Parents Feedback Survey

The survey gathered responses from 167 parents regarding their perceptions of Kumaun University across various aspects of its academic environment. The survey captured a wide array of respondents, encompassing parents from different backgrounds and geographical locations. This diversity adds richness to the data, reflecting a broad spectrum of perspectives on the university's performance. A majority of respondents; 19.8.% are very satisfied and 56.3% are satisfied by with the quality of education and facilities. However, a notable proportion also indicated neutrality or dissatisfaction, suggesting room for improvement in meeting parental expectations.

Communication channels between the university and parents received mixed reviews, with 35.9% finding them very effective and effective, while 25.7% found them somewhat effective, and 20.4% deemed them ineffective. This indicates a need for enhancing communication strategies to better engage parents and keep them informed about academic updates and events.

34.1% have rated the level of interaction between teachers and parents as good and 20.4% as excellent. However, there were also notable proportions reporting average or poor interaction, indicating potential areas for strengthening teacher-parent collaborations. Regarding safety and discipline, 46.7% rated the university's efforts as good, while 27.5% rated them as excellent. Nevertheless, a significant minority expressed concerns, suggesting a need for continuous efforts to enhance safety measures and maintain discipline on campus.

In terms of academic and counselling support services, 66% expressed satisfaction, highlighting the importance of these services in supporting students' academic journey. However, the presence of dissatisfied respondents underscores the necessity of refining and expanding support offerings to cater to diverse student needs effectively.

The relevance and adequacy of the curriculum and study material were generally positively received, with 87.5% agreeing that they adequately prepared students for their future careers. This indicates a perceived alignment between the university's academic offerings and students' career aspirations, reflecting positively on the institution's educational quality.






9. How would you rate the overall infrastructure and facilities available at Kumaun University for students' academic and extracurricular activities?



Feedback Analysis Report: Kumaun University, Nainital Academic Session: 2022-2023

This report presents a comprehensive analysis of student feedback collected during the academic session 2022-23 at Kumaun University, Nainital. It offers insights into the strengths and areas for enhancement of the institution, shedding light on the overall satisfaction levels among students. Feedback was gathered via an online rating system, utilizing a scale ranging from 1 to 5, where 5 denoted 'Excellent,' 4 represented 'Very Good,' 3 indicated 'Good,' 2 stood for 'Average,' and 1 signified 'Below Average.' This methodology facilitated a quantitative assessment of student satisfaction across various domains, including course content, teaching-learning methods, and the evaluation process.

According to student responses, the university received predominantly positive ratings, with an impressive 83.39% of students rating it as 'Excellent.' A breakdown of responses is as follows:

- Excellent (5): 82.55%
- Very good (4): 4.60%
- · Good (3): 2.91%
- Average (2): 2.73%
- Below Average (1): 6.47% These results indicate a highly favorable perception of the university, with 91.14% of respondents rating it as 'Very Good' or 'Excellent.'

Feedback was solicited on five key aspects of course content and delivery, highlighting the university's proficiency in these areas. The evaluation encompassed syllabus coverage, detailed topic discussions, teacher expertise, communication skills, and the ability to inspire students. The high average scores received underscore the institution's excellence in this domain.

Students assessed eleven factors related to teaching and learning, revealing a positive outlook on various aspects including teacher punctuality, engagement, preparedness, guidance,





Student Feedback Survey, Kumaun University, Nainital, 2023-2024

Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted at Kumaun University for the academic year 2023-2024 yielded insights into various aspects of student satisfaction. With 748 responses collected, the survey evaluates teaching quality, resource availability, support services, campus facilities, extracurricular activities, communication channels, tuition fees, hostel amenities, canteen services, career development opportunities, and overall campus culture. The participants represented diverse academic backgrounds across departments such as Pharmaceutical Sciences, Management Studies, Biotechnology, Commerce, Zoology, Law, Agriculture, among others.

Teaching quality emerged as a notable aspect, with 34% very satisfied and 43% satisfied with the overall quality of teaching. The majority acknowledged the standards maintained in teaching. Resource availability raised concerns, as 12.6% of respondents expressed dissatisfied feelings about the accessibility of resources.

Support services, particularly academic advising and counselling, highlighted the scope for improvement, as 27.4% reported high satisfaction and 39.4% of students reported satisfaction, while 11.2% indicated areas needing enhancement. Campus facilities, including cleanliness and maintenance, reported mixed responses, with 31.8% expressing high satisfaction and 11.9% expressing dissatisfaction. In extracurricular activities, the only 60% expressed satisfaction, indicating a desire for more diverse offerings. Communication channels also highlighted areas for improvement, with 29% reporting high satisfaction and 45% were satisfied while 7.1% expressed dissatisfaction, emphasizing the need for better communication between students and faculty/administration.

Concerns regarding tuition fees affordability were raised, with 72.8% satisfied and 27.1% expressing neutrality or dissatisfaction. Hostel facilities and canteen/cafe services similarly showed opportunities for improvement, with 54.4% and 45% satisfaction rates,



respectively. Overall, 68% of students expressed likelihood to recommend Kumaun University to others, indicating potential for enhanced satisfaction levels. Suggestions for improvement included better placement/internship opportunities, facility maintenance, academic resource enhancement, timely communication, and teaching standards improvement.

The student satisfaction survey provides valuable insights into areas of strength and areas needing improvement at Kumaun University. Addressing the identified concerns and implementing suggested improvements will contribute to enhancing the overall student experience and satisfaction levels.




3. How satisfied are you with the support services (academic advising, counselling, etc.) provided by Kumaun University?




4. How satisfied are you with the cleanliness and maintenance of campus facilities at Kumaun University?


How satisfied are you with the variety of extracurricular activities available at Kumaun University?




7. How satisfied are you with the affordability of tuition fees at Kumaun University?






11. How satisfied are you with the opportunities for career development (internships, workshops, etc.) provided by Kumaun University?



Teacher's Survey Report

This report presents an analysis of feedback received from 122 teachers regarding various aspects of the university's functioning. The respondents hold various positions including Professor, Assistant Professor, Guest Faculty, and others. Responses come from diverse academic departments including Botany, Law, Geology, Zoology, Economics, and others.

Approximately 99% of respondents perceive the university's efforts in promoting inclusive decision-making as effective or very effective. A significant majority (92.6%) of respondents feel that the university effectively involves faculty in shaping university-level course content. Around 91.8% of respondents view the university as supportive or very supportive in helping faculty adopt innovative teaching methods. The majority (95%) of respondents believe that the university is likely or very likely to promote collaboration with external experts in academic and industry settings. A substantial portion (95.1%) of respondents rate the university's examination and evaluation system as good or excellent.

Most respondents (92.6%) rate the university's library resources and procedures positively, considering them as excellent, good, or satisfactory. The university is perceived positively in promoting and supporting research activities, with 93.4% of respondents acknowledging its effectiveness. Satisfaction with infrastructure elements such as ICT facilities, classrooms, and labs varies, with the majority expressing satisfaction but notable concerns raised regarding cleanliness and maintenance. A significant number of respondents (89.5%) express satisfaction with the approachability of the university administration and the opportunities provided for academic growth. The effectiveness of the university's grievance redressal system is perceived positively by 86.8%.


Several respondents highlighted the need for fixed norms/guidelines for contract faculty. Improvement in infrastructure, including addressing electricity problems and enhancing internet facilities, was suggested. Some respondents requested research grants or seed money for contract and guest faculty to support their academic endeavours.







3. How supportive is the university in helping faculty adopt innovative teaching methods? 122 responses




4. How likely is the university to promote collaboration with external experts in academic and industry settings?

5. How fair and effective is the university's examination and evaluation system in assessing students' academic performance?




Registrari Camaun University 6. How well-equipped is the university's library with diverse learning resources such as books, journals, and e-resources?


7. How fair and transparent is the procedure for acquiring books and resources in the university library?




9. How satisfied are users with the convenience of accessing the library and the procedures for book issue/return?




10. How satisfied are users with the fairness and transparency of the procurement process for departmental equipment/software?








13. How regularly does the university support faculty participation in national conferences, seminars, and symposia?






16. How satisfied are users with the adequacy, cleanliness, and maintenance of classrooms and furniture?
